***Note on the repotting session at last month's meeting***

The the name of the dendrobium we planted up was incorrect. It is Dendrobium crumenatum. Well known as the "pigeon orchid". It is found in India, Thailand, China and the Philippines. The short-lived flowers are borne on the top, leafless part of the stem. Flowering is initiated by a sudden fall in temperature, producing numerous white flowers, all opening at the same time. It does not appear to require a definite rest and needs watering all year. It is fragrant.
