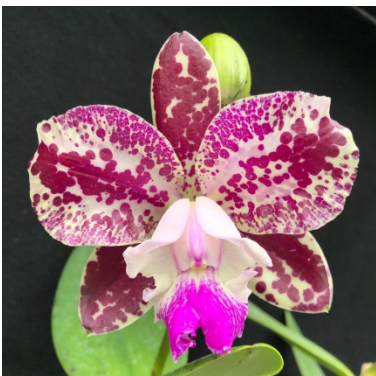


### **Paph. Deena Nicol x stonei**

One of our multiflora hybrids bred for us by Norito Hasagawa. These will be spectacular, boasting three great multiflora species in the background. This type is a bit slower growing but super spectacular in flower. Good for warm climates.

### **C. Caudebec x Lc. Maui Plum**

We are super excited about this cross. C. Caudebec is a large pink flower with dark spots held in clusters and Lc. Maui Plum is a deep reddish-purple flower with many flowers on the spike. The results should be very impressive. Plant size will be tall with good spikes for high drama.

### **Neofinetia falcata**

This is a special offering of beautiful clumps of our select forms of this wonderful Japanese species. We have been breeding these for years and received many awards on our plants, all the while selecting out nice cultivars. Flowers are fragrant like coconut & citrus. Great indoors.

### **Dendrochilum convallarioides**

A super nice species from this genus mostly native to the Philippines. Convallarioides is very compact and good for windowsill growers. The plants will grow very quickly into specimen plants literally be covered in spikes of many orange-pink flowers.

### **Oesterdella centradenia**

This may be our most unusual offering. Plants form a large clump with many keikis to resemble something similar to a fern.

It will be covered with slender canes with soft, light green leaves. In season, the plant will produce many delightful pink flowers completely covering the plant. It is a genus that is closely allied to Epidendrum and very popular.

### **Lycaste skinneri alba**

Lycaste skinneri alba could be the rarest plant we are offering as it's just never seen in the trade, even though it's the National Flower of Guatemala and highly revered. ### **L. Carol Easton 'New Horizon'**

One of the most spectacular plants in our collection. Once specimen size, this puts on an absolutely beautiful show and stops everyone in their tracks. It is a combination of three Laelia species: lobata, perrinii, and purpurata. One of our best growers, it will quickly make a fantastic large plant covered in flowers. This is by far the best of the cross. Limited.

### **C. Horace 'Triumph'**

This plant is the long lost sibling of the very famous C. Horace 'Maxima' which has been the number one breeding Cattleya for the last 50 years, while this exceptional cultivar was tightly held in Europe. For classic Cattleya growers this is a must have.

Flowers are enormous for a C. trianae progeny.

### **Passiflora ligularis**

This species is probably the best tasting species of all Passiflora. It is highly regarded in Latin America where it is known as 'Granadilla'. The plants produce vines which will be covered in orange (not purple) exceptionally yummy fruit.

Not frost tolerant. Not an orchid. Just wonderful.

### **Polystachya campyloglossa**

One of the nicest of the African Polystachyas, this species is found mainly in Zimbabwe. A miniature, but vigorous plant that grows easily producing many spikes during the blooming season (now). Great for windowsill growing.

### **Cyrtorchis chailluana**

This is a beautiful specimen sized plant of a truly majestic Angraecoid species from West Africa. It has approximately 15 growths coming and should be covered with pristine white flowers that are night time fragrant. An unreal opportunity.

### **L. halbingeriana 'Leucadia' HCC/AOS**

This created quite a stir when awarded last year! It's a wonderful example of what is now described as a new species of Laelia from Mexico. In our opinion, it's likely the progeny of a natural swarm combining L. anceps and L. superbiens. Tall spikes carry many beautiful, large lavender flowers. It is quite temperature tolerant and can be grown successfully in Southern California gardens. Very limited.

### **Slc. Golden Wax X Lc. Jalapa**

We have just started to bloom this cross and they have been spectacular. On larger plants expect large heads of flowers in colors ranging from orange to red; many with contrasting lips. Bloom season will be Spring and will lighten up any collection.

### **Maxillaria tenuifolia 'Midnight'**

Though a rather common species, this cultivar is truly exceptional. It is absolutely the darkest variety that we have seen. Happily, it grows freely so is great for beginners or advanced the grower. ## **Myrmecodia platyrea antoinii**

We have a strong interest in growing a few other tropical botanicals and this is perhaps the most unique one we have. It is found from Papua New Guinea to Northern Australia. Look closely and you can see that the plant is covered with soft yellow spines. Tubular white flowers make little orange seeds. The tuber will grow quite large and twist into weird shapes.
