

## Wednesday Walk at Ginini Flats and Morass Flats – 18 March 2009

Mt Ginini is in Namadgi National Park, ACT, in the Brindabella Ranges to the west of Canberra. It was burnt during the 2003 bushfires and we have been observing the regeneration. From the car park at the locked gate at the Mt Ginini end of the Mt Franklin Road, we walked down the old ski run and continued straight down to the south eastern part of Ginini Flats. We were in *Eucalyptus pauciflora* and *E. stellulata* woodland and there were many plants flowering including *Leucochrysum albicans* ssp. *alpinum*, *Podolepis robusta*, *Xerochrysum subundulatum*, *Rhodanthe anthemoides*, *Coronidium scorpioides*, *Brachyscome aculeata*, *B. spathulata* plus massed displays of *Wahlenbergia gloriosa*, *Euphrasia caudata*, *Chionogentias cunninghamii*. The regrowth made it difficult to walk once off the ski run and it was too damaging to walk in the swampy areas. A few managed to go further to Morass Flats and found some additional species including *Grevillea ? australis* and *Olearia floribunda*.
