Largest blooms of any abelia


Pendulous, lavender-pink flowers (the largest blooms of any abelia) bloom spring-fall. New growth takes on red hues in late spring and autumn. This cross between Abelia schumannii 'Bumblebee' and Abelia zanderi 'Little Richard' has a strong root system and compact habit. A good hedge or foundation plant.
