PERENNIAL

1' tall, 2' wide.

Creeping herb, spreads through rhizomes.

Bright green leaves: insignificant, purple flower.

Native habitat: generally under shrubs in woodlands, coastal sage scrub or chaparral; southern California, southern Channel Islands, Baja California.

Full or part shade.

Good drainage.

Try it as an understory groundcover.
