Botanical Name: Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'
Common Name: Ogon Japanese Sweet Flag

Plant Type: Ground cover, Perennial, Grass, Aquatic

Sun: Full, Half, Shade

Water: High, Extra in Summer

This perennial will grow about 6"-12" tall and slowly spreads through rhizomes. It acts like a grass and groundcover. Leaves are thin and variegated with yellow and green stripes. Flowers are considered insignificant. It can tolerate sun or shade but must be in moist soil. This plant can even tolerate being in ponds. It does best in afternoon shade in warm inland valleys.

Botanical Name: Calamagrostis X acu. 'Karl Foerster'

Common Name: Karl Foerster Feather Reed Grass

Plant Type: Grass **Sun:** Full, Half

Water: Medium, Extra in Summer

This ornamental perennial grass grows 4-6' tall x 1-1.5' wide and has semi-evergreen foliage that is green in spring and summer and turns green/brown in fall. The flowers look like feathery plumes; they bloom in mid June and emerge a light green but quickly turn to pink/purple. Flowers look great in a dried flower arrangement. This grass does well in full sun but will tolerate afternoon shade in warm, inland valleys. It needs regular watering and fertile soil. Great for erosion control and in wet areas.

Botanical Name: Calamagrostis foliosa Common Name: Mendocino Reed Grass

Plant Type: Grass

Cool-season bunchgrass native to northern California coastal scrub. Grows 1' tall and 2' wide, with arching blue-green foliage that often has purple highlights. Silver-purple flower heads appear mid-spring through early summer, turning a golden wheat tone in fall. Plant along the coast in full sun or light shade inland in well-drained soil. Tolerates drier conditions when grown in shade but looks best with occasional to regular irrigation. Tolerates wind and salt spray and is resistant to predation by herbivores. Does NOT respond well to being chopped back. Instead, divide existing clumps ...

Botanical Name: *Calamagrostis nutkaensis* Common Name: Pacific Reed Grass

A large handsome bunch grass from the coastal regions of Monterey County to Alaska that forms huge tussocks in open moist meadows and on coastal bluffs. It can also be found as an understory at the edges of coniferous forests. Wide green blades grow 2 - 3 ft. tall with flowering culms to 4 ft. Good background or accent plant for the woodland or meadow. Will take full sun in somewhat cooler areas. Best with some summer water and partial shade inland. Deer resistant. -Cal Flora Nursery

'Frosty Curls' is an attractive grass sedge, that stays less than 1' tall and 2' wide. It can be planted in full sun along the coast but needs afternoon shade in warm inland valleys. It needs regular watering and can be planted close to ponds or boggy areas. Rake the "hair" once in a while. This plant needs regular watering. Foliage is thin, silvery green, evergreen and shoots from a center point and recurves.

Flowers are inconspicuous.

Botanical Name: Carex elata 'Aurea'
Common Name: Bowles' Golden Sedge

Plant Type: Grass, Aquatic

Sun: Full, Half

Water: Medium, Extra in Summer

This Sedge is a short ornamental grass the grows to about 3' tall and wide. It grows in full sun, needing regular watering. If planted in partial shade, this plant will need less watering; foliage will turn more lime green in shade. Foliage is evergreen, starting off in spring as bright yellow, turning green depending on amount of sun. May die back in winter but will come back in spring. This grass will grow in standing water thus making it useful for ponds and boggy areas. In some areas, this plant is used as an annual.

Botanical Name: Carex pansa

Common Name: California Meadow Sedge

Plant Type: Grass

Sun: Full

Water: Medium, Extra in Summer

CA native Carex stays 6" or under and spreads up to 2' by rhizomes. Can be used as a naturalistic lawn substitute. Requires significant water to obtain good coverage, but once coverage is reached water can be reduced and maintenance is close to zero. Unmowed, the plant can be used effectively in a variety of conditions. Prefers sandy soil.

Botanical Name: Carex testacea

Common Name: Orange or Brown Sedge

Plant Type: Perennial, Grass

Sun: Full

Water: Medium

The testacea variety is an evergreen perennial that reaches 2' tall bearing very narrow, coppery brown leaves splitting to hair-like threads at their tips, and continuing to grow to 4-8' in length. This plant should be grown in sun with little or no summer watering. During winter, foliage turns orange. If this grass is planted in shade, foliage stays green. Flowers are insignificant. Orange Sedge looks great in containers or spilling over near walkways or into water features.

Botanical Name: Chasmanthium latifolium

Common Name: Northern Sea Oats

This perennial grass can quickly reach 2'-3' high and 2' wide. Leaves resemble bamboo leaves, turning copper colored in fall and then brown in winter. During summer, flat, dangling, reddish flower spikes appear at the end of curved thin branches. Flowers are wonderful for arrangements. This grass does best in part sun with constantly moist soil. It does well near a pond or wet areas. It tolerates ocean spray.

The tufted hairgrass is a warm season, clumping grass that grows 10" tall with summer flowers that reach to 2' tall. This grass tolerates partial shade and heavy clay soils. It is good in waterside plantings and for mountain area meadows. This grass is a California native and is a beneficial insect plant. Flowers are insignificant.

Siskiyou Blue Fescue quickly reaches 1' tall and 2' wide, with a clumping habit. Foliage is needle-like, blue green and attractive. Flower stalks rise above foliage from spring through summer but are considered insignificant. This plant is grown for its foliage. This grass does best in full to part sun with well draining soil. It attracts butterflies and birds. Very reliable and hardy. Low water use.

Botanical Name: *Festuca mairei* **Common Name:** Atlas Fescue

Plant Type: Grass Sun: Full, Half Water: Low

A long-lived evergreen clumping grass that forms fountain-like mounds to 18 to 24 inches tall and wide with yellowish gray-green foliage. Plant in full sun or part shade in a well-drained soil with occasional to regular irrigation - this plant is fairly drought tolerant when established but looks better (with fewer brown tips with occasional water) when watered regularly. It is quite cold hardy as a dormant grass (USDA Zone 4) and stays evergreen in warmer climates. It is tolerant of diverse soil types and does not need to be cut back, but benefits from a spring raking to remove older foli ...

Common Name: Creeping Red Fescue, Red Fescue

Creeping Red Fescue is not red but dark green. It is a great ground cover kept at longer lengths for banks. It is very shade tolerant and lush looking. This is a great substitute for lawns as it doesn't need to be mowed. It does best in cool summer areas but will tolerate shade in hot inland areas. Hair-like blades reach 1'-2' tall. It does best with sandy or loam soil that is well draining and acidic. This fescue attracts wildlife. Great for erosion control. It tolerates cold but not heat. It needs moderate amount of water and more during hot spells.

This weeping grass has amazing foliage: long thin green leaves have gold edgings. It can slowly reach 15" tall and spread about 24", with a clumping habit. Yellow green flowers appear in summer. Sun requirements are a bit tricky: the variation in leaves are more pronounced in sun but this grass burns in hot summer areas. In complete deep shade, the gold edges turn to lime green. Thus, it does best in cool summer areas. Leaves turn pinkish in fall. It does best in well draining, fertile, moist soil. May need to water more during hot summer months. Prune leaves in winter. The Blue Oat Grass is an evergreen, blue clumping grass that grows 2' tall and 3' wide. Foliage is thin blue gray, wiry leaves that radiate from center of plant. Its showy tan flowers are on spikes 1'-2' above the foliage (flowers more common in cooler winter areas). This plant looks good alone as well as in mass plantings. It does well in full sun or light shade. Established plants need only occasional watering. It does best with well draining soil. The blue oat grass likes dry hill sides.

Botanical Name: *Juncus patens* **Common Name:** California Gray Rush

Although a wetland plant, Juncus patens can tolerate fairly dry conditions. It will slowly clump to 2'-3' wide and tall. It tolerates full sun to full shade. This California native can adapt to various watering needs: it can be planted in a pond or used in dry shade or full sun with occasional irrigation. This attractive perennial, mostly thought of as a grass, has thin, gray green, vertical stems. Leaves looks like small brown sleeves near the plant base and can have a sharp edge. This is a great plant for containers and dry shade. It is deer resistant. It has spreading rhizomes. Mostly g ...

Botanical Name: Lomandra 'Platinum Beauty'
Common Name: Platinum Beauty™ Lomandra

This perennial grass reaches about 3' in height. Leaves are glossy green with white variegation, shiny, firm, flat. Each cluster has a sharp, slender, straw-colored bract at its base, which gives it a dense spike-like structure. It flowers in late winter/early spring, with fruiting 1-2 months after flowering. The plant is tolerant of sandy, loamy and clay soils. It can grow in semi-shade (light woodland) or no shade. It is a low water needing plant.

Each cluster has a sharp, slender, straw-colored bract at its base, which gives it a dense spike-like structure. It flowers in late winter/early spring, with fruiting 1-2 months after flowering. The plant is tolerant of sandy, loamy and clay soils. It can grow in semishade (light woodland) or no shade. It is a low water needing plant.

Miscanthus sinensis is popular ornamental grass. Red flowers are held well above foliage clumps, appearing in summer, and may be cut for fresh or dry arrangements. This plant is highly invasive and really should not be planted in many parts of California. Go to www.rightplant.org to get more regional info. Miscanthus needs full sun and watering at least once a week and more during hot summers. Foliage is variegated, with a thin white band down the center. This grass does great in coastal as well as warm inland valleys.

Dwarf Eulalia Grass is a terrific residential garden performer. It's moderate size, 1.5' feet tall and wide, making it a perfect size for a shrub border. It throws up white spike flowers 2.5 ' tall and wide that last for 2 months in the winter months or late fall.

The 'Morning Light' is also a taller variety, growing to 6'-8' tall and 4'-5' wide. It has delicate feathery plumes and very thin graceful leaves. This is a variegated form with white leaf margins that shimmer in sun. It should receive sun to part shade, and average watering but more during hot spells. This plant looks better with more irrigation. Tall grasses are highly combustible.

This grass will reach 2.5'-3.5' tall and has narrow, green leaves. Eulalia will arch and have an 8' wide spread. Golden flower spikes appear in spring, lasting through winter, shooting up 6' tall. Eulalia is drought tolerant once it's established but give occasional water to spruce it up. It prefers full to part sun. Give this grass some width area.

Wonderful planted in mass with a solid wall background to highlight the flowers. Also attractive plantedin the open next to a pond or pool. The delicate, airy flowers wave and shimmer in the wind. Good on banks of seasonal creeks, along roads or in gullies where runoff forms in winter. Prefers sun, not picky about soil, and looks best with water once or twice a month once it's established. Very long-lived.

Botanical Name: Panicum virgatum Common Name: Switch Grass Plant Type: Perennial, Grass

Sun: Full Water: High

This perennial grass will grow 3-6' tall and 2-3' wide. It has narrow, deep green and gray green leaves with slender, light-colored flowers (panicles) that bloom in midsummer. During fall, foliage turns yellow with hints of orange, then turning tan colored in winter. Panicles are source of food for birds during winter. This grass prefers full sun with wet, sandy or clay soil. It's a great plant for water or bog gardens. Cut back to the ground in early spring to keep it tidy.
