AMELANCHIER AMABILIS, A NEW NAME. In the September number of this Journal (RHODORA, xxii. 149, 1920) the writer made the combination A. grandiflora. While the paper was in press the same name was proposed by Rehder (Journ. Arnold Artoretum, ii. 45, 1920) for a hybrid Amelanchier common in the Eastern United States. The name **A. amabilis** is, therefore, proposed to replace the name A. grandiflora antedated by the A. grandiflora of Rehder.—K. M. WIEGAND, Cornell University.
