 New foliage is golden, then matures to chartreuse. Fragrant, citrusy, showy white flowers Spring. 6'H x 5'W; USDA 8-10; full sun; dryer, well-drained soil
- Pale stems and narrow, blue-tinted leaves, with dime-sized flowers in Spring (occasionally reblooming in Summer).
 3-4'H x 3-4'W; USDA 7-10; full sun; dryer, well-drained soil.
- More compact that other Choisya. New foliage is golden green, maturing to deep forest green. Nickle sized, citrusy flowers in Spring. 2-3'H x 2-3'W; USDA 7-10; dappled shade to full sun.
- ▲ Glossy, finely cut leaves have a spicy scent. Glaucous buds open to very fragrant, citrusy, showy white flower in late Spring. 5+H x 4+W; USDA 8-10; full sun; dryer, well-drained soil.

Native to southwestern North America and Mexico, Choisya, or Mexican Orange, is known for its abundance of fragrant, star-like flowers. This aromatic evergreen impresses planted en masse or as a border shrub, and makes a superb container specimen. Deer resistant, drought tolerant, and attracts hummingbirds, bees and butterflies.
