

Aeschynanthus radicans, commonly called lipstick plant or lipstick vine, is an epiphytic evergreen vine from Malaysia with slender trailing and arching stems originating in tree branches. It has long, red, tubular flowers in dense terminal clusters. Its leaves are dark green, elliptical, fleshy and smooth-edged. It is an attractive flowering vine for use in hanging pots.

### Landscape

Commonly called century plant, is a rosette forming perennial succulent. It is perhaps most noted for its attractive leaves and its huge drooping flower stems. Spineless, fleshy, ovate, light gray to pale yellowish-green evergreen leaves form a large symmetrical rosette. In most types, suckers/offsets root at the base of the rosette forming over time a colony of rosettes.

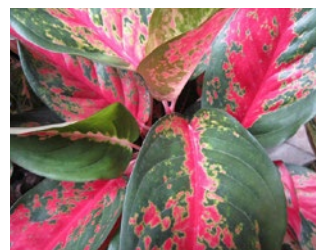

False Aralia has slender leaflets that grow in a circle at the tops of stems so that they look like fingers, giving this house plant another common name: Finger Aralia. New coppery brown foliage turns a dark, blackish-green as the plant matures. Its narrow, serrated leaflets give this small tree a lacy appearance, making it a graceful addition to a collection of tropical house plants.

## Bromeliad



### Foliage

In general bromeliads are stiff leaved, rosette forming plants with brightly coloured leaves, bracts and flowers. The one thing most bromeliads have in common is the rosette formation of the leaves. This rosette can collect and hold rainwater, ing leaves and forest debris from which the plant draws nutrients as they decay. Bromeliads are often sold with bracts and flowers already present. They can retain the bracts for months.

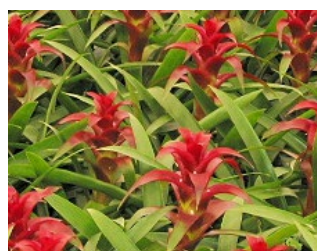

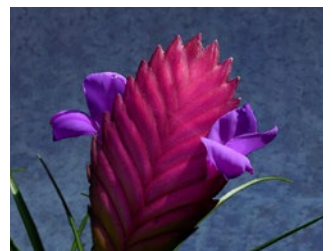

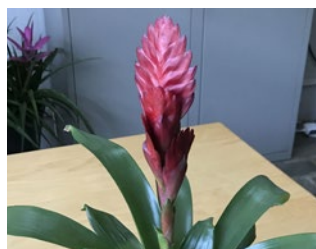

## Caladium



### Foliage

Grown exclusively for their bold and colourful foliage. Calla-type flowers, if present, are usually hidden. Plants typically grow in clumps to 30-75cm tall. Arrow-head-shaped leaves (to 45cm long) are various shades of green mottled or blotched with pink, red, white or combinations thereof often with distinctly coloured veins.

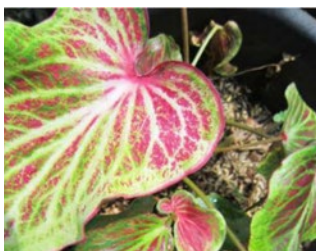



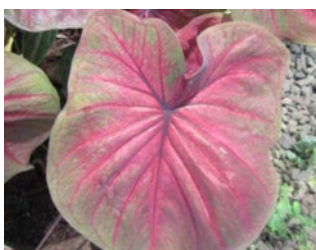

## Carnivorous Plants

**Foliage**

Carnivorous plants are especially adapted for capturing and digesting insects and other animals by means of ingenious pits and traps. The Venus flytrap, *Dionaea muscipula*, is native to subtropical wetlands. If an insect wanders in, the trap quickly closes, forming a prison.

*Nepenthes* is a tropical pitcher plant. Their pitcher traps create inescapable pits for attracted insects.

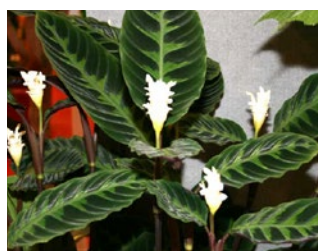

## Chlorophytum

**Foliage**

Garden height 30–40cm. Chlorophytum Green-Orange plants are primarily used as indoor house plants, but in the summer they make a great patio plant as long as they are kept in indirect sunlight. Green-Orange displays rich green leaves with bright orange stalks. This vibrant colour stretches up through the vein of the leaves. The roots develop bulbs filled with water that allows the plant to survive drier periods.

Black Magic Colocasia produce clumps of large long-stalked heart-shaped leaves. They reproduce via tubers or rhizomes. They are a deep purplish-black through their stems and leaves both. They provide an excellent dark contrasting colour in the landscape. Colocasia are also known as taro a type of elephant ear. Plant this Colocasia in sun to part shade. Colocasia needs moist soil and it is important to not let them dry out.

### Foliage

A woody-based perennial that typically grows to 1.8m tall. Noted for its bold, often strikingly colourful foliage. Glossy, smoothed-edged leaves are in bright colours ranging from yellow, pink, orange, red, bronze, purple and green or combinations thereof in patterns involving blotching and striping. Use as a tropical accent in containers and border gardens. Can also be kept indoors, the best colour and overall vigor is achieved with plenty of bright light.



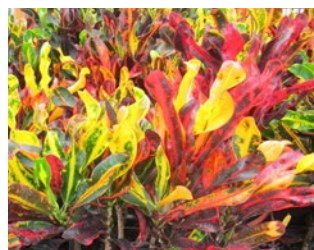
