


Coastal Boobialla

Myoporum boninense subsp. australe myo-POOR-um bon-IN-ense subsp. oss-TRAH-lee



This hardy attractive plant can grow as a small shrub or sprawling prostrate ground cover.

Produces clusters of small white flowers through spring and summer, followed by smooth vibrant light to dark purple fruit. This plant naturally grows in coastal areas and would make a great addition to a garden bed. Looks great planted en masse.
